

New Ethnic businesses go green and join the Bin Trim program



The progress report of Bin Trim program ECC has been submitted to and approved by the funding organisation EPA in the first week of March. The second stage of the program has sailed smoothly. Approximately 90 new ethnic businesses have joined the program. All have received the initial waste assessments.

The Bin Trim program of ECC has continued to work with local councils. Two local councils have provided support letter to the program. Ku-ring-gai Council's Love Living Ku-ring-gai program and Better Business Partnership are now working closely with the team to provide waste management recommendations and assistance as well as energy and water reduction services to the businesses located in the Ku-ring-gai local government area.
